



(Parable of the Sower, the Seed and the Soil)

Luke 8:4-15 NLT

Luke 8 isn't just an academic study of how evangelism works, or a bunch of observations Jesus made during His ministry. It's a call to action.

Any person who wants to follow Christ is going to be a co-laborer in cultivating His Kingdom. There will be times when you spread seed, receive seed and cultivate the soil.

The competent farmer knows what needs to be done, when it needs to be done, where to do the work and how to do it.

The Sower will see the best return on what they plant if they work in the field God gave them.

1 Peter 3:15-16 NLT

Ask God to give you opportunities to share with others, then be diligent so you don't let them pass you by.

Be liberal when scattering your seed.

2 Timothy 2:15 NLT

The farmer must handle the seed they broadcast correctly.
