

1. Today's story is very unique in that this story is only recorded in Luke!

- Luke 10:1 (Some versions will say 70 and others 72 depends on the manuscript)
- In the OT...Moses appointed 70 elders as his representatives. Numbers 11:16 & 24-25
- The heart behind the calling of these men was to <u>help share the load</u> and <u>allow God to</u> <u>move in an even greater way by the Good News said</u>! (You see this with the 70 in Luke)
- It is very important to see that the <u>same qualifications</u> that God had for the men that were picked, <u>are the same qualifications in the New Testament</u>! Exodus 18:21-23
- Let's look at Acts 6:3, I Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:6-9
- As you can see, God does not slide or skip on His expectations of leaders and Christians!

2. Jesus had a mapped out plan!

- Jesus sent the 12 disciples into Galilee. Matthew 10/ Luke 9 (we will reference this later)
- The 70 were sent into *every city and place* where Jesus was *about to go*!
- <u>Think about that!</u> They were the messengers <u>before Jesus arrived</u> sharing the Good News that was on the way! (This was the launch pad for Jesus arriving!)
- Nothing has changed with us today! We take Jesus into every place that we go and this is how the message is spread around the world! <u>Before Jesus comes back again</u>, we are his messengers telling everyone about Him! You have

<u>A. Jesus sent the 70 in 2 x 2! Verse 1</u>

- Jesus sent the 12 in 2 x 2 as well! Mark 6:7
- Why? There is strength and wisdom in numbers! Ecclesiastes 4:9, Acts 13:2, Acts 15:27, 39 & 40, Acts 19:22 and Revelation 11:3. (Some things change with people...realize that)
- Verse 2 Jesus tells them about the <u>harvest of people</u> that are ready to be saved...<u>but</u> not many were out sharing!
- It was in this very moment that Jesus tells them to pray and that God would use them to go start! (Same principle today)
- Notice verse 2 "Lord of the harvest" God knows who is ready and who is not!
- Verse 3 "<u>lambs among wolves</u>" these 70 would face <u>much hostility</u> and <u>spiritual</u> danger! Ezekiel 2:3-6, John 15:20, Matthew 7:15 and John 10:12
- Verse 4 "<u>neither money bag, knapsack or sandals</u>" this simply meant that they were going to travel without luggage, extra sandals and money.

- <u>Why?</u> Jesus was teaching them to <u>trust Him</u>! God would take care of everything for them on this <u>particular trip</u>! <u>Verse 5</u> – "<u>Peace to this house</u>"
- Verse 5 "<u>greet no one</u>" a greeting in that culture was a very elaborate ceremony! It involved formalities, a meal and long delays. A person sent on an <u>urgent mission</u> could be excused back in these days from all of this without being thought of as rude.
- Everything in Jesus' message to these 70 was that the time is short and the urgency is great! <u>Why?</u> Jesus only had so much time here before being Crucified and Risen.
- Verse 6-8 if they were welcomed into a peaceful home, they were to stay there and establish their "headquarters" at that house. They would then go throughout the city each day sharing of Jesus coming soon! The owner of the home was honored to feed them when they returned! (*Reaching the lost during the day / Discipleship at night*)
- Verses 9-11 The choice of receiving or rejecting is so important for your Eternity!
- Verse 12 <u>The result of rejecting</u>! <u>Sodom and Gomorrah</u>! <u>Matthew 10:15</u>
- These cities and the surrounding region were judged without warning and with the utmost severity!
- The priority was to preach that the King had come and His Kingdom was near!
- The message of Jesus was and is always the main thing! Signs and miracles are given from God when God decides to advance the Kingdom how He wants! We are to believe!
- <u>Please note</u> <u>Jesus already paid the full price for us by His life and sacrifice</u>! This is <u>why</u> we pray to the Lord according to His Will He does what He does!
- When the Jews rejected the message "shake off the dust from your feet" this is an expression of disdain! An expression of disgust against such a prideful and arrogant attitude. Acts 13:51 (This was a public showing that you are no better than the pagans with demon gods)
- Jesus gave the Jews a chance first! Romans 1:16 / Many Jews rejected Jesus, so the Gospel spread to the world!
- Verses 13-15 there was a prophecy all of the way back in Ezekiel about Tyre and Sidon being totally destroyed! Chorazin, Bethsaiada...both were cities near Capernaum...the point is that the entire area would be judged!
- Why? Capernaum was the chosen city where Jesus set up His headquarters!
- It would face an even <u>harsher judgment</u> since they literally had the King right there!
- What's interesting, is that there is <u>not any record</u> of the people there mocking Jesus or ridiculing Jesus. But, the <u>SIN OF INDIFFERENCE</u> was the sin there!
- Jesus said that <u>their indifference towards Him</u> was <u>worse</u> than Sodom's gross wickedness!

Closing: Don't reject the message of Jesus Christ today!

- Verse 16 people are not rejecting the Pastor or Christian...they are rejecting Jesus himself! The only result is judgment!
- But, for the person who loves, embraces and accepts Jesus and His message...Life now and Eternal Life is your reward with Jesus forever! John 3:16-17 (Good News!!!)
