

"Lord, Teach us how to Pray."

## Luke 11:1-13

**<u>1.</u>** Luke 11:1 – "Lord teach us to pray...just as John taught his disciples."

- Rabbis would write prayers for their disciples to pray and recite. John did this with his disciples.
- Jesus' disciples watched him pray very often and saw the love that he had for prayer and time spent with the Heavenly Father!
- They also knew that prayer was not just the reciting of words!
- Jesus had taught them in Matthew 6:7 "When you pray, don't babble on and on as the Gentiles do. <u>They think</u> their prayers are answered <u>merely by repeating their</u> words again and again."
- Luke 11:2 Jesus said "This is how you pray:" / Jesus is giving the heart of how to pray!
- Luke 11:2 "Father may your name be kept Holy."
- First of all, we pray to our Heavenly Father in Jesus name!
- We do not pray to anyone else!
- The false prayers that have <u>been created</u> and are <u>being created by humans</u> and church leaders are <u>so far off from the Bible</u>!
- Example Praying to Jesus' mother Mary. It is done by MILLIONS and MILLIONS daily!
- You are to NEVER to pray to her or anyone else according to the Bible!
- Mary was a human and sinner!
- Luke 1:47-48 Mary said, "How my spirit rejoices in <u>God MY Savior</u>! For he took notice of this <u>LOWLY SERVANT girl</u>..." / Romans 3:23 – 'For ALL have SINNED and fall short of the Glory of God!"
- Jesus gives the same prayer twice! On the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew 6 and here. Jesus is answering this question from his disciple.
- "Your name" = <u>All</u> of who God is...His <u>complete</u> character and <u>all</u> attributes!
- Verses 2-4 shares that God's Will be done on earth as in Heaven...let us live according to His Will // Give us each day our daily bread (food physically and spiritually...John 6:35 Jesus said "I AM the Bread of Life" // Forgive us of our sins as we forgive those who sin against us // Don't let us yield to temptation and deliver us from the Evil one.
- 2. More teaching on Prayer!
  - Luke 11:5 Then, teaching them more about prayer, he used this story..."

- Luke 11:5-8
- Verse 8 is so key here! "But, I tell you this if you keep on knocking long enough..."
- <u>Don't stop</u>! <u>Don't give up</u>! <u>Don't quit</u>! <u>I Thessalonians 5:17</u> "<u>Never stop Praying</u>!"
- <u>It's called persistence =</u> urgency, faith, audacity, earnestness, boldness, and relentlessness!
- Verses 9-10 Ask...seek and knock! <u>Keep on doing this</u>!

## 3. God is our Good Father!

- Verses 11-13
- Fish or a snake? Egg or a scorpion?
- <u>What's the point?</u> If your kiddo asks you for something, you being <u>an earthly father</u> who is not perfect <u>WOULD NOT hurt your child</u>! What father harms their kid?
- Verse 12 "<u>Of course not</u>!"
- So...if an earthly father has that kind of heart to not hurt their children, <u>HOW MUCH</u> <u>MORE</u> does our <u>PERFECT HEAVENLY FATHER</u> love you...His children?!!!!
- Verse 13 "If you sinful people know how to give good gifts your children, how much more will your Heavenly Father give the HOLY SPIRIT to those who ask him."
- What an incredible promise here!
- <u>The Holy Spirit</u> convicts us, cleanses us, guides us, leads us, fills us and most of all backs up Jesus (God's Word) 100% of the time!
- You receive the Holy Spirit at Salvation (John 3:3 / Ephesians 1:13 / Romans 8:9-10 / I Corinthians 6:9-11 & 19-20) and He will continue to work in your life as long as you live!
- I can't think of a better prayer request answered by God to me and you than to have God, Jesus and the Holy Spirt given to me and you for our lifetime!

## Closing: Communion

- Let's take time today to remember what Jesus Christ has done for us in the Salvation of our very souls!
- He was beaten and hung on a cross, shed His blood for the forgiveness of all of our sins and died for us!
- We now have Eternal Life with Him forever IF we turn to Him and repent and put our faith in Him and His name!
- What an incredible and precious gift from our Heavenly Father to give His One and Only Son for us! John 3:16-17
