

"The Great Banquet!"

#### Luke 14:15-24

I love a good Banquet! Usually, you have a really great main dish with some amazing sides! Then dessert!!!!!

Jesus shares a Parable about how many were invited to a Great Supper Celebration...and they rejected the offer from the Master of the house! Let's check it out...

#### 1. Attend a Banguet in the Kingdom of God!

- Luke 14:15
- Jesus shared what He said to a man who had the viewpoint that only Jews would be invited to the future Heavenly Feast/Banquet one day! It was common among the Jews.
- Matthew 8:11-12 Jesus says that many of the Jews will never be in Heaven! <u>Why?</u>
  They rejected Him as God and Messiah! Yet, the invitation is open to everyone else!
- This Parable shows us that everyone is invited to Heaven, YET they must turn to God with repentance, and accept Jesus and live for Him! John 3:16-17
- Luke 14:16 Great Banquet with MANY invitations sent out!
- Interestingly, when the invitations were sent out...<u>no one declined at that time</u>!
- Luke 14:17 <u>The Banquet was ready!</u> The Master of the House sent out his servant to let all of the guests know its time! Come to the banquet!
- Guests for a wedding were all pre-invited and given a general idea of the time!
- When everything was ready, the **pre-invited guests** were to be at the Banquet!
- <u>Here is the KEY</u>: <u>Israel is the pre-invited guest(s)!</u> The Old Testament scriptures, prophets and preachers told Israel <u>to be READY</u> for the coming Messiah! Jesus!

## 2. Excuses!

- Luke 14:18 "But they ALL began making excuses!"
- Every excuse that is given in the next few verses are full of insincerity!
- Luke 14:18 "I just bought a field and must inspect it!"
- A person does not purchase property without seeing it first! This was an excuse! Since the purchase was already complete, there was <u>ZERO</u> urgency!
- Luke 14:19 "I just bought five pairs of oxen, and I WANT to try them out."
- You don't purchase oxen without trying them out first! This was an excuse!

- Luke 14:20 "I just got married, so I can't come."
- The Jews did not take a cruise or go to the Bahamas for their Honeymoon! They literally went to the house that the husband built! So, this was an excuse!
- You can be together at the Banquet, and then still go home together afterward...you newlyweds! <sup>(i)</sup>

## 3. The invitation is opened to Everyone!

- Luke 14:21 The pre-invited guests just got booted! They lost out!
- Who got invited? "The poor...crippled...blind...lame" = Romans 10:13
- The Jewish Pharisee's regarded any other people as not chosen by God!
- The religious leaders of the day always condemned Jesus for His associations with reaching out to sinners to be saved!
- Luke 5:29-30, Luke 15:1-2, Matthew 11:19 & Matthew 21:31-32!

#### I love Luke 14:22! There is still room for more!

- Notice the word "urge!"
- Why is this so important? Because, there is a DAY coming when it will be too late!
- <u>We must reach everyone now!</u> Remember last Sunday...no one knows when Jesus will return...we must be watchful and ready!
- The Good News is only Good News if it arrives on time for someone!

### The HEART of the Parable? Luke 14:23 - "Go everywhere so that the house will be full!"

• <u>Highways and hedges</u> = the Gentile regions! Open to everyone who would choose!

# <u>The sad reality?</u> Luke 14:24 – "For <u>none of those I FIRST invited</u> will even get the <u>smallest</u> <u>taste</u> of my Banquet!"

- This is not the Master of the House being mean! This is the people <u>rejecting the</u> <u>invitation</u>! <u>They REFUSED to come!</u>
- <u>Because of the Jews rejecting</u> the very One that God sent (John 3:16) His One and Only Son, <u>His judgment was the only result!</u>
- In 70 A.D., Jerusalem was burned to the ground because the Jews rejected and refused God's invitation to be saved! They MURDERED His One and Only Son!
- They lost God's Hand of Protection over them!

## Closing: Matthew 28:18-20

- <u>The Great Commission! "Go into all of the world!"</u>
- It is the *greatest invitation* to all of humanity!
- Jesus doesn't want crowds...<u>He wants Disciples</u>!
- Remember our story today in Luke 14. It ends on verse 24 right? Nope!
- Look at verses 25-27 He teaches the multitude that they need to be a Disciple...not just a fill a seat or be a number in the crowd!
- See, it is up to you on who you want to become in Jesus and where you want to serve!
